General Data Protection Regulations Hanging Basket Scheme Participants Privacy Notice

When you participate in the Town Council's Hanging Basket Scheme, the information you provide (personal information such as name, address, email address, phone number) will be processed and stored so that it is possible to contact you and respond to your correspondence, provide information, send invoices and receipts relating to your participation. Your personal information will not be shared or provided to any other third party without your consent.

The Council's Right to Process Information

General Data Protection Regulations Article 6 (1) (a) (b) and (e)

Processing is with consent of the data subject or

Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation or

Processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller.

Information Security

Maldon Town Council has a duty to ensure the security of personal data. We make sure that your information is protected from unauthorised access, loss, manipulation, falsification, destruction or unauthorised disclosure. This is done through appropriate technical measures and appropriate policies. Copies of these policies can be requested.

We will only keep your data for the purpose it was collected for and only for as long as is necessary. After this it will be deleted. You may request the deletion of your data held by Maldon Town Council at any time.

Access to Information

You have the right to request access to the information we hold on you. You can do this by contacting us directly.

Information Correction

If you believe that the information we have about you is incorrect, you may contact us so that we can update it and keep your data accurate. Please contact the Town Clerk (details at the top of this form).

Information Deletion

If you wish Maldon Town Council to delete the information about you please contact the Town Clerk to request this.

Right to Object

If you believe that your data is not being processed for the purpose it has been collected for, you may object by contacting the Town Clerk.

Rights Related to Automated Decision Making and Profiling

Maldon Town Council does not use any form of automated decision making or the profiling of individual personal data.
